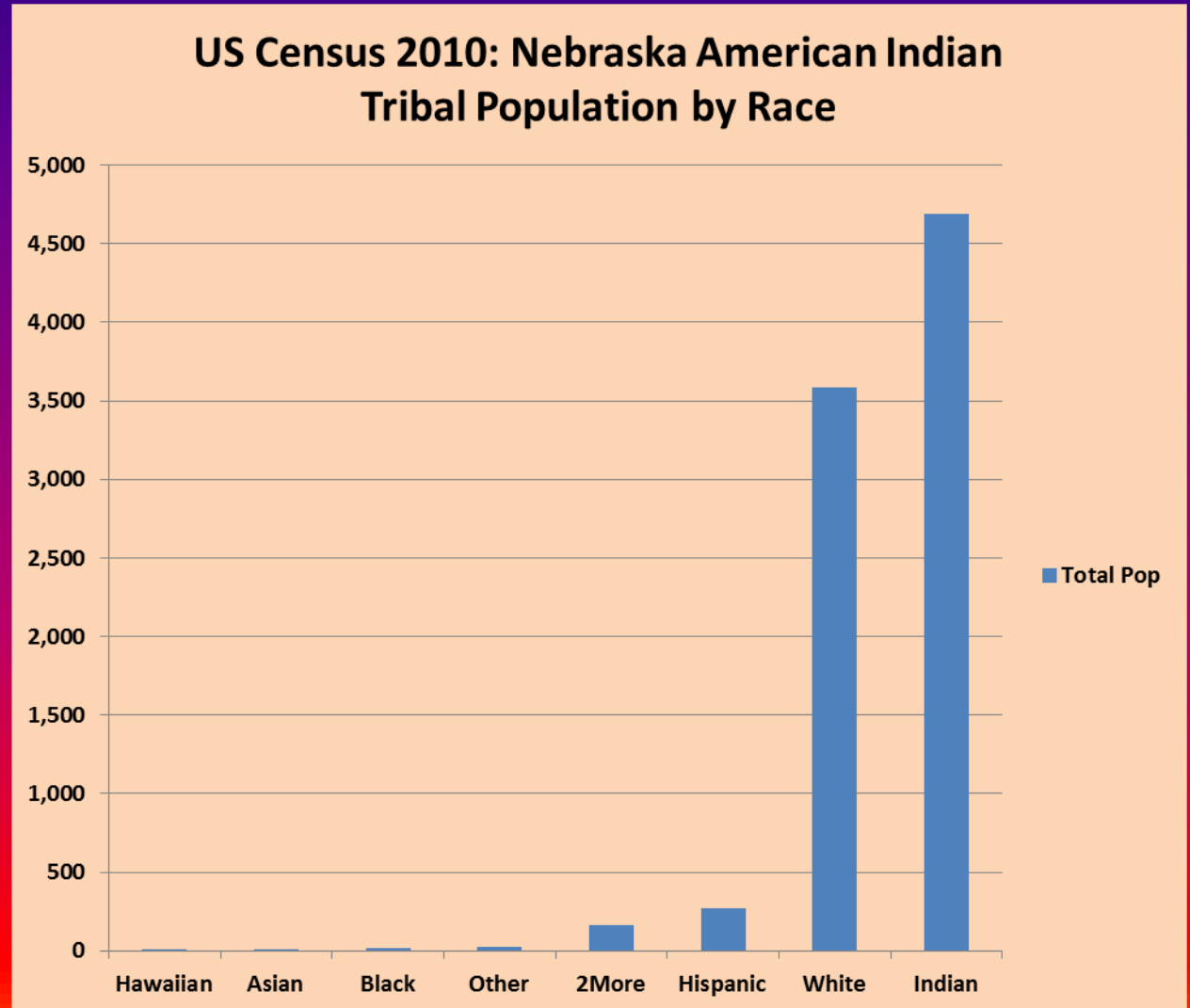

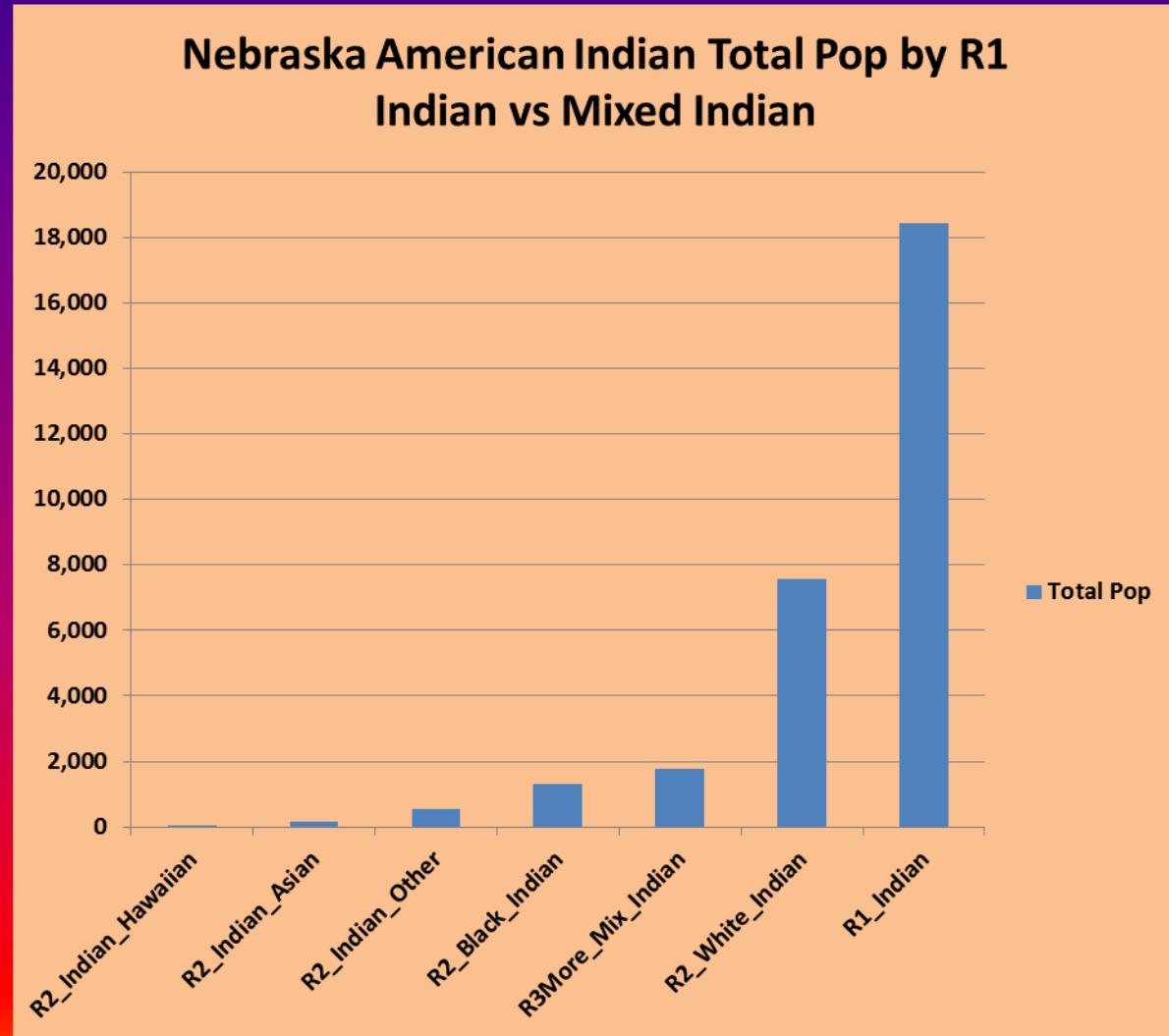

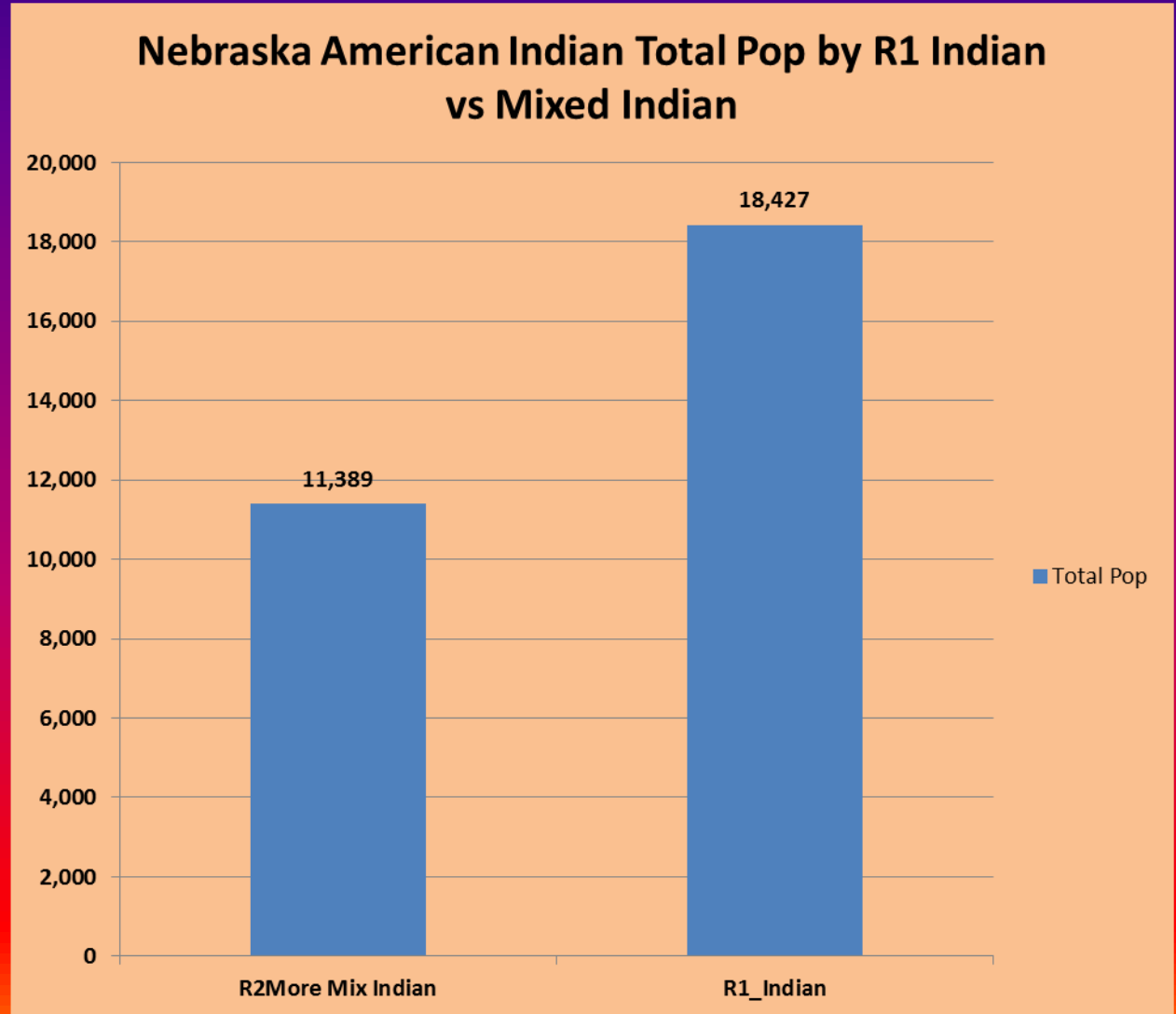

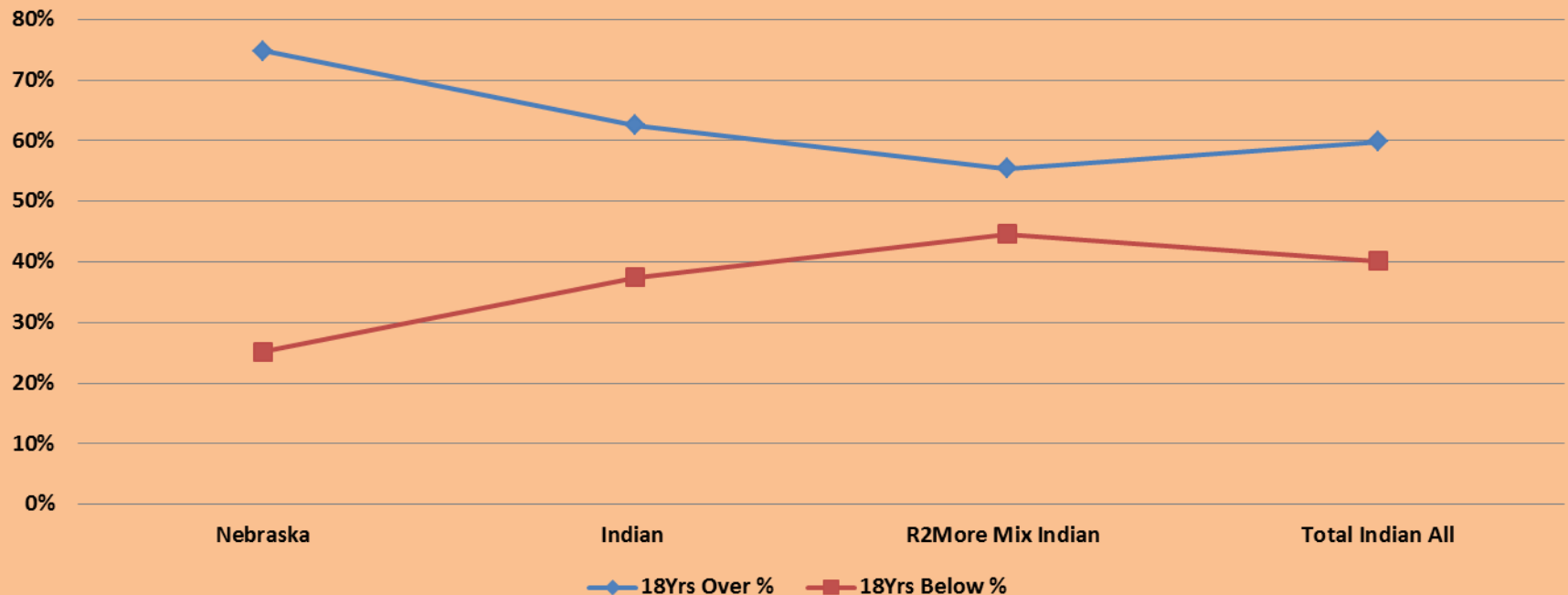

**US Census 2010: Nebraska American Indian Population % : 18 Yrs Over vs 18 Yrs Below**



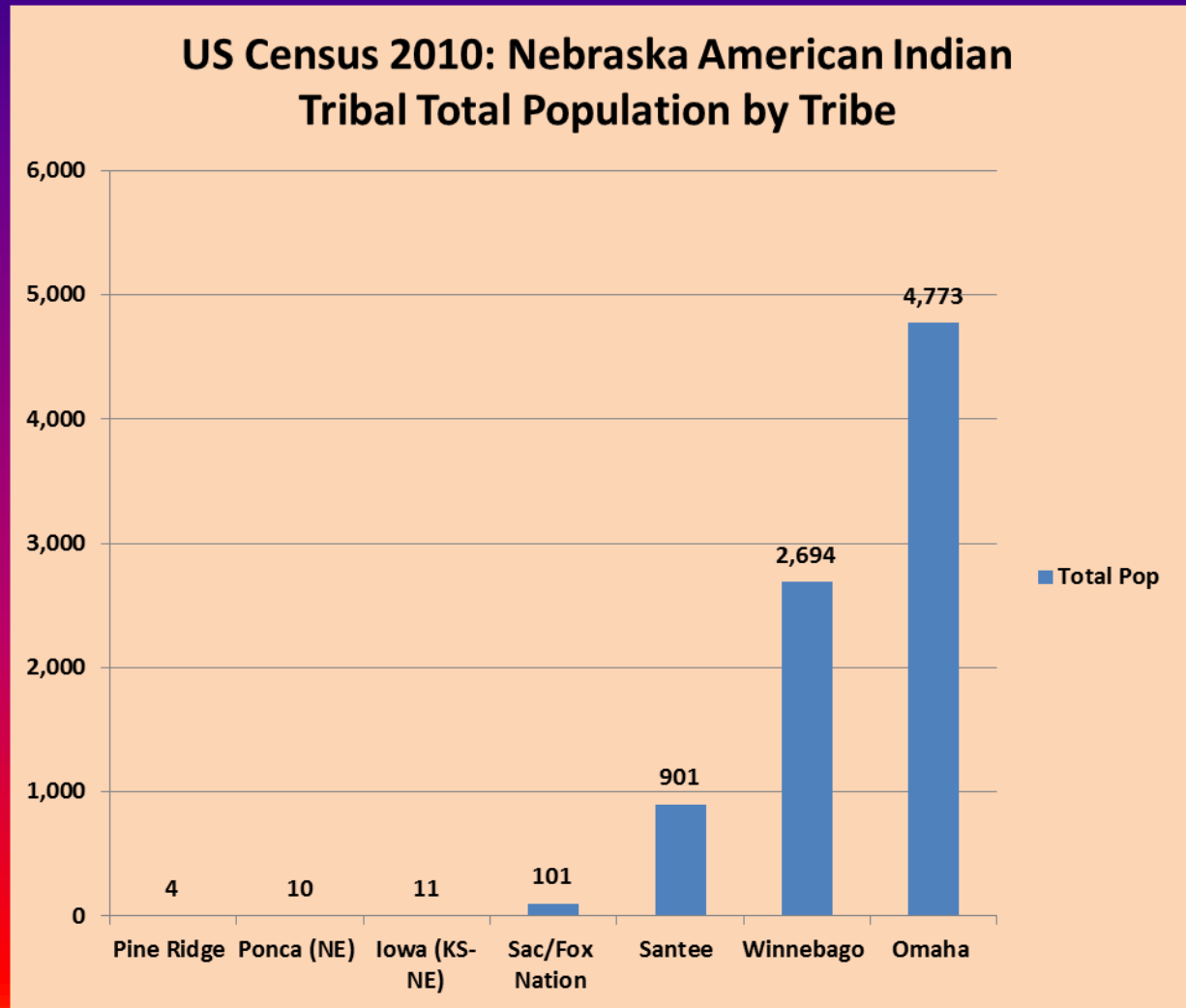

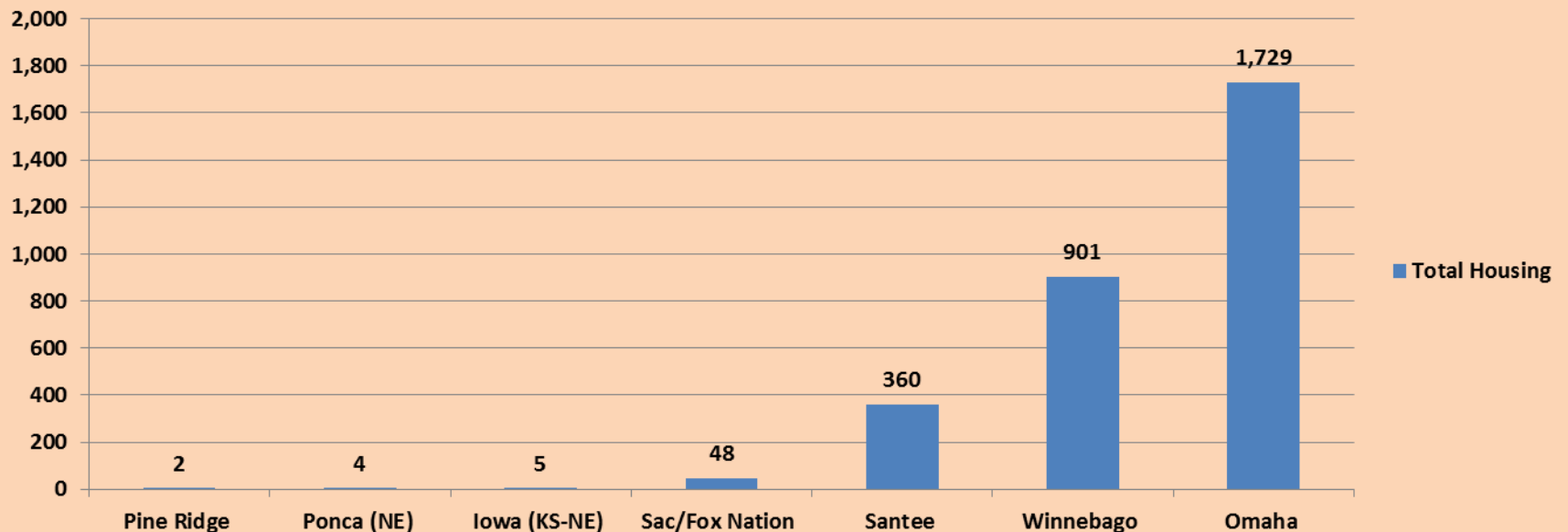

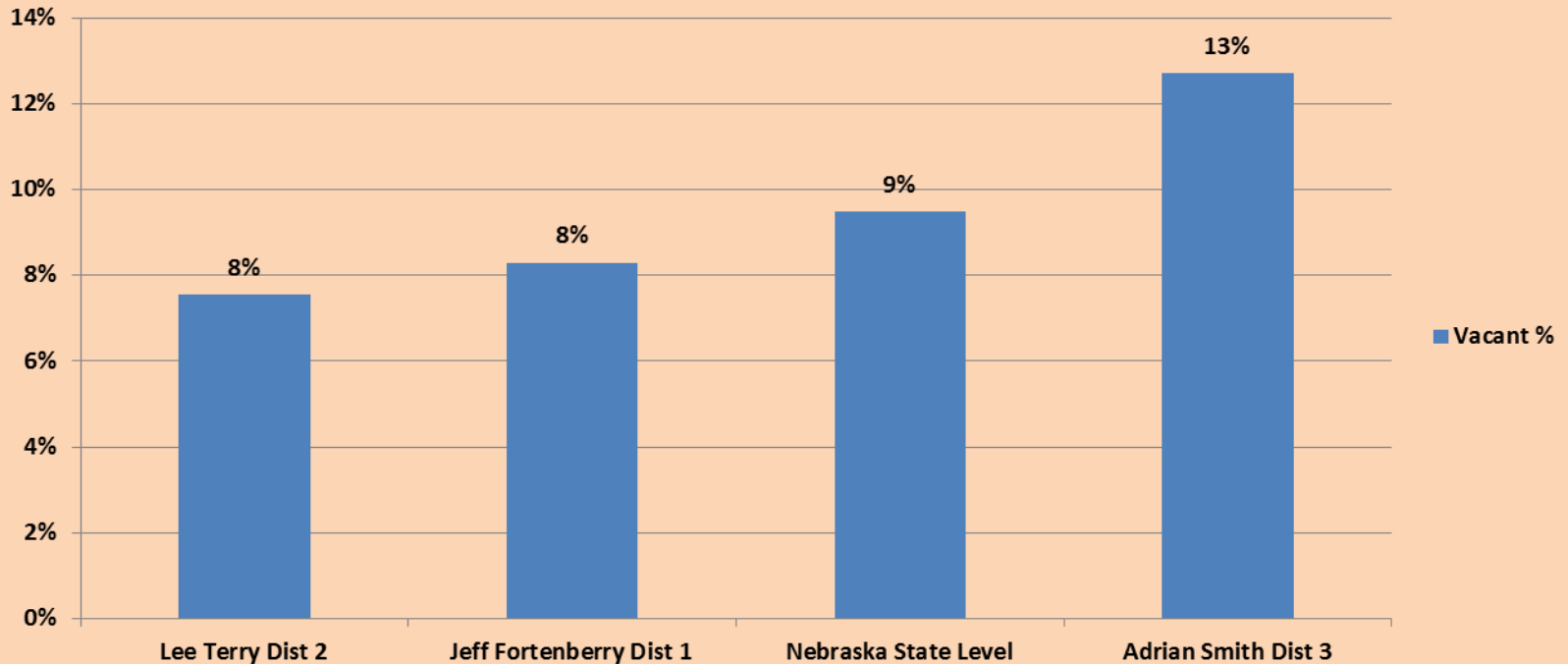

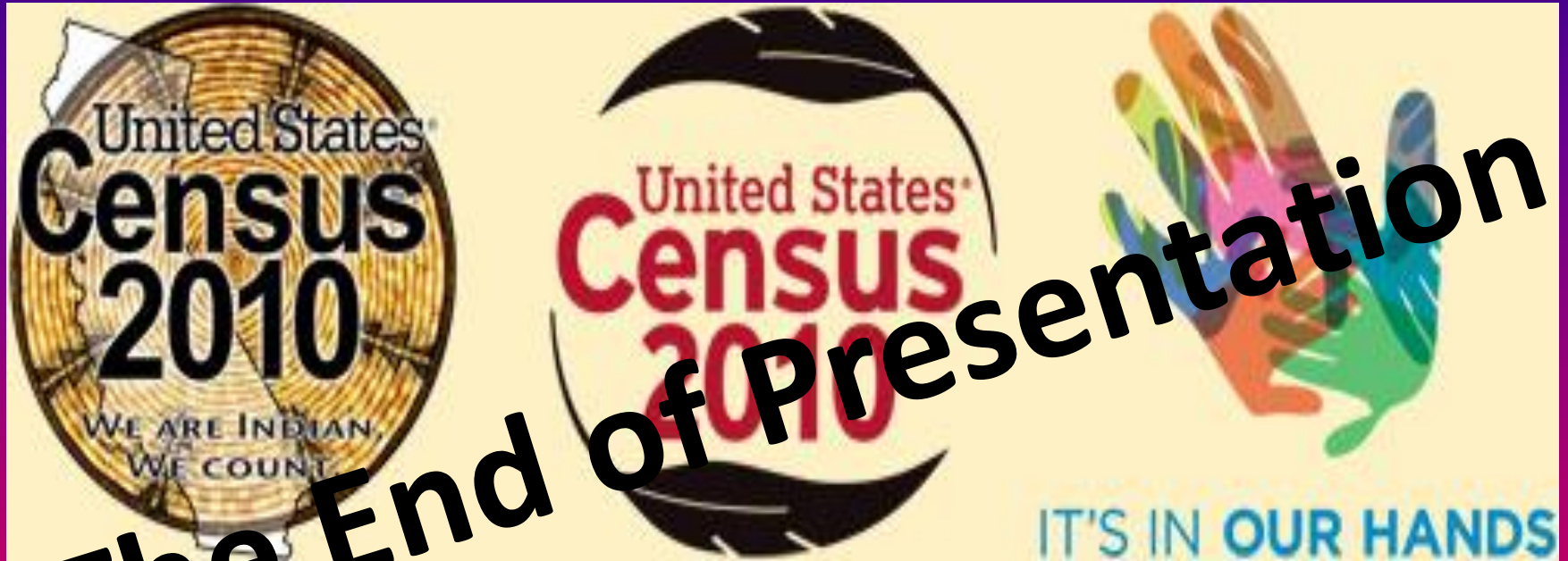
