

1-7-1) The Ten Commandments of Sikhism

- 1. Worship One God
- 2. Treat Everyone Equally
- 3. Live By the Three Primary Principles;
 - 1) Be always absorbed in meditation and prayer.
 - 2) Make an honest income by honorable methods.
 - 3) Share earnings and selflessly serve others.
- 4. Avoid the Five Sins of Ego; 1) Pride 2) Lust 3) Greed 4) Anger 5) Attachment
- 5. Become Baptized
- 6. Keep the Code of Honor; Ethical and spiritual commitments
- 7. Wear the Five Articles of Faith; 1) Sikh undergarment for modesty/health 2) Wooden comb in the turban; Clean hair 3) Steel wristlet; Faith 4) Hair uncut; Honor the creator's intention.
 5) Small sword symbolic of defending the religious rights
- 8. Follow the Four Commandments; 1) Do not dishonor the creator by cutting the hair 2) Do not harm the body with tobacco or other intoxicants 3) Do not eat sacrificial meat 4) Do not commit adultery.
- 9. Recite the Daily Prayers; Morning, Evening, Bedtime
- 10. Take Part in Fellowship; Worship together and sing God's praise.
